



Mojave National Preserve and the California Department of Fish and Game invite you to participate in a youth Quail and Chukar hunt, October 23 and 24, 2010

- Any youth of legal hunting age to 18 who has successfully completed a hunter safety class and has the appropriate licenses is welcome. Parents or adult guardians are encouraged to attend but cannot hunt. Youth will be paired with an experienced hunter as they guide you on a hunt to harvest these elusive gamebirds. Hunt schedule and departure will be determined.
- Enjoy talks and lessons on the North American Model of Wildlife Conservation, Gun and Backcountry Safety, Low impact Camping, Natural History of Gambel's Quail and Chukars, field care and dressing harvested game.
- Enjoy Friday evening barbecue of hamburgers, Saturday breakfast of eggs, sausage and bacon then a Saturday night feast on hotdogs and hopefully quail and chukar. Make sandwiches to go for the hunt.
- Bring you tent, camp trailer, motorhome and enjoy two nights and three days on the Preserve. However, there are no trailer hookups, but water and pit toilets are available.
- Shotguns and ammunition can be made available for your use by request.
